The bi-knife also marked with the makers name "LYON EDINBURGH". The black wooden traditional hilt finely carved overall with basket work design and inset with tiny metal studs. Complete in its black leather scabbard with matching mounts. Single edged blade with some signs of wear and use, the back edge of blade is scalloped and the blade has the makers name F. A. LYON EDINBURGH. Overall length in scabbard is 17 inches. A nice rare Scottish piece that could probably be traced to the family through the crest & initials. In well used condition. Ref 3789.
